This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for conducting fair and proper investigation by police officials of Crime Branch of IPS rank outside District SAS Nagar, in case FIR No.122 dated 25.06.2020, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 49 IPC, Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), whereby the petitioner and her daughters have been falsely implicated by the police officials.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner was falsely implicated in subject FIR and she has given a representation dated 07.11.2020, (Annexures P-6 and P-7) to the official respondents, however, no action has been taken so far by them. He contends that necessary directions be issued for registration of a case against the private respondents.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that the FIR against the petitioner was registered in June, 2020, wherein she is on bail and the representation was given by her in November, 2020.

the representation, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C., as the petitioner can avail the alternative remedy.

The petition is dismissed.
