This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.29 dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Section 61 of The Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the very outset submits that instant petition may be treated as representation on behalf of petitioners and further respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police (Investigation), District Gurdaspur, may be directed to look into matter and decide the same within a stipulated period.
