Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 11.01.2018, vide which the petitioners were summoned to face trial in proceedings under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and also to quash the complaint (Annexure P-2).

This petition is pending since long and on 23.09.2019, following orders was passed by this Court: -

“Counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that a settlement had been arrived at between the parties and as per the settlement, the petitioners have made the payment of first installment of Rs.10 lacs, however, the trial Court has passed an order dated 12.06.2019 vide which the warrants were issued against the petitioners though the authorized representative of the petitioners was present with the settlement/agreement. It is further submitted that as on today as per the settlement, an amount of

Rs.57 lacs is payable and the petitioners are still ready to pay the said amount and submits that he will bring a demand draft of Rs.20 lacs within a period of 04 weeks and will also make the balance payment after a period of another 01 month thereafter.

List again on 06.11.2019.

The petitioners are directed to bring a demand draft of Rs.20 lacs favouring the complainant on the adjourned date.”

The aforesaid order dated 23.09.2019 has not been complied with by the petitioners, despite availing number of dates.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
