Through this revision petition the petitioner-tenant has assailed the order assessing the provisional rent passed by the learned Rent Controller which has been upheld by the Appellate Authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to spread of COVID-19 pandemic, the petitioner is not in a position to continue to pay the rent. He submits that the petitioner would hand over vacant physical possession of the tenanted premises to the landlords-respondents by 31.1.2021.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of as no further orders is required to be passed. The petitioner would submit an undertaking in the aforesaid terms before the Rent Controller and will hand over the keys of the tenanted premises on or before 31.1.2021 to the landlords-respondents before the Rent Controller.
