Prayer in this application under Order 23 Rule 3 read with Section 151 CPC is for disposal of appeal in view of compromise (Annexure A-1).

Notice of the application to counsel for the non-applicants/respondents.

Mr. Lokesh Sinhal, Advocate accepts notice.

Counsel for the applicants-appellants would state that dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise and as such the appeal may be taken on board and disposed of accordingly.

Counsel for the non-applicants/respondents, on instructions from Ram Kumar, statedly present in the Court concedes to this fact. He would further state that Smt. Chotti – non-applicant/respondent No.1 has since passed away and Sh. Ram Kumar being the son of Smt. Chotti is the only legal heir left behind by her.

Affidavit of Ram Kumar and death certificate of Chotti were produced and taken on record.
