1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

At the outset, learned counsel states that in view of order dated 14.12.2020, passed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, District Ludhiana, in compliance of order dated 15.09.2020 in CRM-M No.27782 of 2020, deciding representation dated 27.08.2020, submitted by the petitioners, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the contempt petition, with liberty to challenge order dated 14.12.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
