The grievance of the petitioners is that although they have completed the work way back in the year 2013-14, their entire dues have not been paid till date. A sum of almost Rs. 6 crores is due, complete details of which have been mentioned in the writ petition. The petitioner has approached the competent authority on many occasions but they have not deemed it appropriate to make the payment.

Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity of filing a written statement.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to consider this writ petition as a representation and to decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. In case it

is found that money is due to be paid, the same be paid within a further period of four weeks.
