Mr. Satvir Singh, Advocate for Mr. A.S. Manaise, Advocate appears on behalf of the petitioner and files power of attorney. The same is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Petitioner in this case was aggrieved of the respondents action in not releasing the amount due towards him after successful completion of work allotted to him. As per affidavit dated 22.02.2019 of the Executive Engineer, Construction Division PWD(B&R), Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab, final bill of Rs.46,74,865/- was released vide Treasury Vr. No. 01 dated 06.03.2018 (Annexure R1/T) and the maintenance bill of Rs.20,64,043/- was released vide Treasury Vr. No.02 dated 31.10.2017 (Annexure R2/T).

Learned counsel for the State submits that in this view of the matter, this writ petition is rendered infructuous and same may be disposed of as such.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however submits that he has no instructions in this regard.

In view of affidavit dated 22.02.2019, this writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say, in case of any dispute regarding the amount in question, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to him.
