Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking protection of her and her children life and liberty and also for giving direction to the official respondents.

On the oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak is impleaded as party in the array of parties as respondent No.5.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that State has no objection in impleading the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak as respondent No.5 in the present petition.

Registry is directed to carry out necessary corrections in the Memo of Parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak to consider his grievances in this regard and for the same purpose he will file a detailed and comprehensive representation to the Deputy Commissioner within one week from today.

Learned State counsel submits that State has no objection in case the present petition can be disposed of at this stage with appropriate directions to the Deputy Commissioner to take action in accordance with law.

In view of the above, it is directed that in case the petitioner files representation before the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order then the Deputy Commissioner, Rohtak shall consider the representation of the

petitioner and to take further measures in accordance with law, preferably within four weeks thereafter.
