Present petition has been filed with a prayer that respondent No. 2 be directed to decide Petition No. 203 of 2016, which is pending consideration with respondent No. 2 since 2016, especially, in view of the fact that the similar claim of the other land owners, has already been allowed whereas, the claim of the petitioners is being kept pending by the respondent No. 2 for the last about 4 years and that too without any valid justification.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel submits that the petition No. 203 of 2016 filed by the petitioners under Section 3G of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking enhancement of the

compensation awarded by the Competent Authority will be decided by respondent No. 2 within a period of three months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order, in case the same has already not been decided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the undertaking of the learned State counsel recorded above, his grievance, as raised in the present petition, no longer subsists and he does not press this petition any further.

Present writ petition is disposed of as having been not pressed.

It is made clear that respondents will be bound by the undertaking recorded above.
