Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners have filed revision petition against the order dated 12.09.2019 passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, which is pending consideration before the respondent No.2 since January, 2020 and the non-decision of the said application including the application for the grant of interim order is causing prejudice to the petitioners.
