Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for conducting fair and proper investigation by police officials of Crime Branch of IPS rank, in case FIR No.112 dated 21.11.2020, under Sections 447/511/506/148/149 IPC, Police Station Mahal Kalan, District Barnala and to protect his life and property from private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner was falsely implicated in the subject FIR and he has given a representation dated 23.11.2020, (Annexure P-10) to the official respondents, however, no action has been taken so far by them. He contends that necessary directions be issued for registration of a case against the private respondents.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that the investigation is pending in the subject FIR and the petitioner is on bail.

Considering the nature of offences and the averments made in

the representation, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C., as the petitioner can avail the alternative remedy.

The petition is dismissed.
