The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Nidhi Rani and Kapil Sharma, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents no.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. They have placed on record Marriage Certificate, Annexures P-3, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) to Superintendent of Police, Kaithal.

Notice of motion has not been issued, but Mr. Navjot Singh, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No. 4 and submits that he has instructions to state that father of petitioner No.1 does not have any objection to the marriage.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-5 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
