The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 143 dated 13.05.2020, registered under Sections 323, 341, 452, 307, 506, 356, 148, 149, 188 of the IPC (Section 382 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 10.09.2020 passed in CRM-M-20300-2020, vide which co-accused Amandee Rao and Rajat Bhagi @ Raja have been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that due to a sudden fight between the two groups, injuries were sustained by both the parties, however, later on, the matter stands compromised.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Vikasdeep Singh, Advocate, who are also appearing through video conferencing,

accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant, respectively.

Learned counsel for the complainant acknowledges that there is a compromise between the parties.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing him a written notice in this regard.
