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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.28,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Counsel further submitted that appellant No.4-Mehar Chand (Father of the deceased) has since died and therefore, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellants 1 to 3, in full & final settlement of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit one cheque in the sum of Rs.10,00,000/- favouring appellant No.1 and two cheques in the sum of Rs.9,00,000/- each favouring appellants 2 & 3 with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 08.04.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
