The petitioners assail the inaction of the authorities in issuing them Sports Gradation Certificates of Grade 'D' as per the policy guidelines dated 25.05.2018 and 15.11.2018 and the judgment of this Court dated 09.10.2020 in *LPA-1332-2019*, titled '*State of Haryana and another vs. Shankar and others*', and batch. Though the petitioners claim to have submitted applications for issuance of the aforestated certificates, Mr. Jasbir Mor, their learned counsel, fairly concedes that they did not retain copies thereof and are therefore not in a position to produce any evidence of submission of such applications.

As it is for the authorities concerned to consider as to whether the petitioners would be eligible for grant of such certificates as per the guidelines and the directions of this Court in the aforestated judgment, it would be appropriate to allow them an opportunity to undertake this exercise and take a decision.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of permitting the petitioners to make applications afresh along with supporting documents before 5.00 P.M. on 18.12.2020. In the event such applications are received, the authority concerned, viz., the District Sports and Youth Affairs Officer, Hisar, District Hisar, respondent No. 3 herein, shall consider the said applications in the light of the policy guidelines and the law laid down by this Court and take necessary further action. In the event the petitioners are found ineligible for issuance of the certificates, a detailed order shall be passed indicating the reasons therefor. This exercise, one way or the other, shall be completed by 25.12.2020, under intimation to the petitioners.
