Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to release entire retiral benefits in his favour.

Petitioner has retired as Junior Engineer on 31.03.2020. However, till date complete entire benefits have not been paid to the petitioner. With regard to his grievance, petitioner has made a representation dated 22.09.2020 (Annexure P-2), but no action has been taken thereon till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 22.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and pass a speaking order thereon in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Petitioner is also held entitled to

Randhawa vs. State of Punjab and others, 1997 (3) SCT 468. After passing of the speaking order, payment, along with interest, shall be released within the next one month.
