Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 199 dated 21.11.2020 registered under Sections 186, 353, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have falsely been involved in the present case and they have nothing to do with the alleged offence as mentioned in the FIR. The petitioners were not present at the spot and nothing is to be recovered from them, therefore, no custodial interrogation is required.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the petitioners had not only manhandled a public servant on duty but also removed his turban and torn his uniform. He also points out that the turban is yet to be recovered from the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed, as no ground is made out to grant the concession of interim bail to the petitioners.
