The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 267 dated 04.10.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 34 of the IPC at Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner and co-accused have caused injuries to complainant Sucha Singh.

Learned counsel further submits that matter has already been compromised between the parties and complainant Sucha Singh had made a statement on 09.11.2020 before the Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Arnav Sood, Advocate, who are also appearing through video conferencing, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant, respectively.

Learned counsel for the complainant acknowledges that there is

a compromise between the parties, which has been effected by the respectables of the village considering the fact that both the parties need to maintain peace and harmony in the village.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing him a written notice in this regard.
