This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No.1 and 2 to grant No Objection Certificate to the petitioner for appearing in scrutiny of documents on 3.9.2019 and interview on 4.9.2019, for the post of Assistant Professor (Bio-Chemistry).

At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner has pointed out that earlier the objection of the respondents was that the State authorities had not issued NOC to the petitioner. However, now the State authorities have even issued the NOC to the petitioner to join services with the respondents, if he is found to have been selected during the process of selection.

At this stage, the sealed cover containing the result is opened. The result declared by the respondents shows that the petitioner has been selected

in the said selection process as per his merit.

The counsel for the respondents has submitted that the petitioner would be permitted to join the post for which he is found selected.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

The result of selection, which was earlier handed over in a sealed cover, be re-sealed and handed over to the counsel for respondent No.3.
