Petitioners have posed a challenge to the demand notice whereby additional price is sought by the HUDA on account of enhancement in the compensation for development of Sector 8 Part, Jind.

At the outset, learned counsel appearing for HUDA submits that the amount has been recalculated in view of revised policy dated 22.08.2019. *Ipsa facto* the demand notice already issued would stand withdrawn.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for HUDA, no cause of action survives in this petition. Same is hereby disposed of.

Needless to observe that the petitioners shall be at liberty to file afresh in case any grouse subsists after *de novo* exercise is completed by the HUDA.
