Preent petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India with a prayer to protect the petitioner and her family members from the illegal threatening and harassment being caused by respondent No.4 due to their ulterior motives in order to pressurise the petitioner's family and for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and personal liberty and property.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that there was one FIR No.231 dated 28.11.2020 registered under Sections 302/34 IPC at Police Station City Patti in which the son of the petitioner, namely Jagroop

Singh is not an accused. However, the police officials of the police station Patti have been repeatedly raiding the house of the petitioner to arrest him and to cause harassment illegally to the petitioner and her family. Learned counsel has further submitted that the said Jagroop Singh was not obeying the petitioner and her family, therefore, he was disowned by them and is not residing with them. Moreover, the petitioners do not have any information with regard to his whereabouts. He has further submitted that in case at any time, it comes to the knowledge of the petitioners with regard to the whereabouts of the son of the petitioner, they will immediately inform the police. However, the police officials cannot repeatedly raid the house of the petitioners where the said Jagroop Singh is not residing and cause unnecessary harassment to them. Petitioner No.1 is 42 years old widow lady, petitioner No.2 is 19 years old boy and son of petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.3 is 16 years old daughter of petitioner No.1 and they are being unnecessarily and illegally harassed by the police officials of police station Patti. He has therefore prayed that appropriate directions be issued to the higher officials of the police department to look into the matter and not to harass the petitioners. Vide Annexure P-1 petitioner No.1 had given representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran on 03.12.2020 but nothing has been done in this regard.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Asst.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and states that State has no objection in case at this stage if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I am satisfied that this petition can be disposed of at this stage without calling for the reply of the State so that appropriate directions may be issued to the concerned authorities.

Consequently, it is directed that the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran – respondent No.3 shall look into the representation (Annexure P-1) and proceed further with regard to the grievances of the petitioners as aforesaid and if required, take action in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
