GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner-Lokram
inter alia praying for quashing of the transfer order dated 28.08.2019
(Annexure P-1).

A perusal of the order dated 28.08.2019, shows that the petitioner
was transferred from Bhiwani to Rohtak. This Court on 02.09.2019, passed
the following order:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that
the petitioner is to retire on 30.06.2020, but vide impugned
order Annexure P-1 dated 28.08.2019 has been transferred
from Bhiwani to Rohtak, which is against the transfer policy.*

Notice of motion for 13.02.2020.

*In the meantime, there shall be interim stay of
Annexure P-1 dated 28.08.2019 qua the petitioner.*

*Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, learned Deputy Advocate
General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents
and seeks time to file reply.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
supply six copies of the paper book to the learned State*

counsel during the course of the day.”

After notice of motion, short reply has been filed by Shri Sandeep Khirwar, IPS, Inspector General of Police, Rohtak Range, Rohtak on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. In the short reply, it has been mentioned that vide order dated 31.10.2019, the order dated 28.08.2019 has been cancelled.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of.
