The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction to respondent No.2 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner, as respondent No.3 is threatening the petitioner at the behest of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Before approaching this Court, petitioner has submitted representation dated 13.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, which is pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to examine the representation dated 13.12.2020 (Annexure P-4).

Without adverting to the merits of the petitioner's allegations at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No. 2 to consider the representation dated 13.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation dated 13.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) be sent to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
