Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Hisar, the petitioner, assails the order dated 25.11.2020 whereby the District Magistrate, Hisar, cancelled the 'No Objection Certificate' granted to it in relation to installation of a petrol pump at Village Chaudheryas, District Hisar.

The aforesaid order of cancellation would be appealable under Rule 154 of the Petroleum Rules, 2002. Mr. Ashish Kapoor, learned counsel for the petitioner-Corporation does not dispute this fact. He would however inform this Court that a similar writ petition filed by the petitioner-Corporation was disposed of on 15.12.2020, relegating it to the appellate

remedy but with a further direction to the appellate authority to dispose of the stay application filed by the petitioner-Corporation in such appeal within one week. Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, does not dispute this.

In that view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of leaving it open to the petitioner-Corporation to avail its appellate remedy before the Commissioner, Hisar Division. In the event any stay application is filed in such appeal by the petitioner-Corporation, the appellate authority shall consider and dispose of the same on merits within one week.
