Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.14 dated 20.02.2020 registered under Sections 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Subhanpur District Kapurthala.

A perusal of the order dated 11.04.2020 passed by the Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala, show that the petitioners were granted interim bail awaiting the report of the FSL with a clear condition that they will surrender in case the recovered quantity of the intoxicant powder is found to be commercial and in the event of non-compliance of the said order, the bail order shall stand cancelled automatically.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court be directed to decide the regular bail application of the petitioners expeditiously.
