The grievance of the petitioners is that options given by them for transfer have not been taken into consideration, whereas, options given by their juniors have been accepted. Even, representations dated 25.8.2020/20.8.2020 (Annexures P2/A to P2/D) have not elicited any positive response.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, a direction be issued to decide the aforementioned representations by passing a speaking order.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek a written statement.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider aforementioned representations (Annexures P2/A to P2/D) in accordance with relevant rules and law and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
