GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners-Kulwant Singh and two others, *inter alia* with the prayer for direction to respondent No.3 to take action on demand notice dated 19.07.2017 (Annexures P-1 to P-3), sent by the petitioners to respondent No.4.

2. The records of the case show that on 12.01.2018, notice of motion was issued for 03.05.2018. Today, on the resumed hearing of the case, learned State counsel appearing for respondents No.1 to 3, submits that vide order dated 09.02.2018, the case has been referred to the Labour Court for adjudication. She submits that in view of this, no further orders are called for as the substantive relief prayed for, has been granted. This fact has not been disputed by counsel for the petitioners as well as counsel for

respondent No.4.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.
