The petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 10.12.2020 revoking suspension of respondent No.6-elected Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat Pali, District Faridabad.

Some facts are required to be noticed.

The term of elected members of the Gram Panchayats in the State is due to expire in the month of January, 2021. Respondent No.6 was placed under suspension vide order dated 26.11.2020 on the ground that a sum of Rs.21,600/- is required to be recovered from him. A preliminary inquiry was held in which he was found guilty of embezzlement of a sum of

Rs.21,600/-. The Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad, while ordering regular enquiry, placed him under suspension. The inquiry is pending.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana on instructions from Ms. Priyanka Mathur, ADA, Office of DDPO, Faridabad, has informed that respondent No.6 has already deposited the amount in question. He submits that it is on account thereof the suspension of respondent No.6 has been revoked.

After having heard learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the considered view that there is no illegality or perversity in the order revoking suspension of respondent No.6 particularly when he has already deposited the amount.

However, the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad is requested to get the regular inquiry concluded positively within a period of four months.

In view thereof, the present writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the above-stated order.
