Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer that he has filed a mercy appeal (Annexure P-14) before the respondent claiming that he be awarded his B.E/B. Tech Degree by rounding off the marks secured by him i.e. 39.76% to 40%, keeping in view the law laid down by the Division Bench of the Himachal Pradesh High Court, which judgment has already been upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India (Annexures P-12 and P-13 respectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mercy appeal dated 03.11.2020 (Annexure P-14) is still pending consideration with the respondent authorities and he will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said mercy appeal by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent is directed to decide the mercy appeal dated 03.11.2020 (Annexure P-14), filed by the petitioner, if not already decided, by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
