Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that respondent No.4 is the father of petitioner No.1 who is a police official working in Chandigarh police.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 4.12.2020, in this regard, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the Counsel of UT, Chandigarh.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Ashima Mor, APP, UT, Chandigarh, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage certificate (Annexure P3).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Station House Officer, Police Station Sector-26, Chandigarh, to look into the representation Annexure P-4 dated 4.12.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
