ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, finding that the Court is not convinced, limits his prayer and submits that petitioner may be permitted to surrender before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today and the trial Court may be directed that in case the petitioner moves any regular bail application before it, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today and in case she moves any regular bail application before the trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously, preferably within a period of two days thereafter.
