1. Mr. Rohit Suri, learned Counsel for the Petitioners is unable to satisfy the Court on why the Petitioners should not be relegated to pursue their statutory remedies under the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002 before the Debts Recovery Tribunal.
2. The Court is accordingly not inclined to exercise its discretionary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution, to interfere in the matter at this stage.
3. Leaving it open to the Petitioners to exhaust the statutory remedies available to them in accordance with law, the petition is dismissed.
