Through this writ petition, under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for a writ in the nature of Certiorari, the quashing of the result declared on 05.12.2020.

The petitioner claims that he applied for the appointment, pursuant to a recruitment notice for the post of Elementary Teacher in the State of Punjab. He appeared for the written examination which was held on 29.11.2020. The answer key, thereof, was published and uploaded on the web on 30.11.2020. The objections were invited. The petitioner submitted objections to the answer key published with respect to question no.43, 52, 55, 59, 95 and 95. The matter was referred to the experts who after considering the objections, decided to grant marks with respect to questions no. 52, 59 and 75. The grievance of the petitioner is that answer to questions no. 43, 94 and 95, are not correct, therefore, this Court should interfere.

With the help of the learned counsel, for the petitioner, this Court has examined the questions. In exercise of power of judicial review this court in absence of definite authentic material does not find it appropriate to interfere.

Still further, as noticed above, the Supreme Court has already examined this aspect and held the Court cannot sit in appeal over the decision of the experts. It is not in dispute that the candidates have already been granted opportunity to file objection, which have been considered and the candidates have been granted marks for question no. 52, 59 and 75.

In view thereof, no ground to interfere.

Hence, dismissed.
