The petitioner has approached this Court, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to cancel the consolidation proceedings carried out during the year 2013-14 and for fresh consolidation.

Prayer made by the petitioner is totally misconceived as no such order can be passed in the manner prayed for in this case specially when the aggrieved party, if any, has statutory right available under the East Punjab Holdings (Consolidation and Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948. The said remedy having not been availed against the consolidation which stood concluded in the year 2013-14, the writ petition at this belated stage is not maintainable and the same, therefore, stands dismissed.
