The grievance of the petitioners is that their application for recalling order dated 6.3.2020, whereby, their revision petition was dismissed in default is not being taken up for consideration. ROR-687-2019 was filed challenging the order dated 5.7.2019 (Annexure P-4), whereby, the partition suit was decided ex parte without service upon the petitioners. On account of non-decision of the application for recalling, grave injustice is being caused to the petitioners.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek a written statement.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the concerned Financial Commissioner before whom application for recalling order dated 6.3.2020 passed in ROR-687-2019 is pending to take up the same expeditiously for final disposal.
