The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.194 dated 12.08.2019, under Sections 354-C, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that in fact, the matter stands compromised and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karam Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation. In fact, the matter has been compromised

between the parties.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
