This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.119 dated 16.07.2019 under Sections 306 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dakha District Ludhiana. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 04.09.2019 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners along with her son had gone to her parental house to reside with petitioner Nos.2 to 4, which was opposed by the complainant as well as the victim. According to him, the victim committed suicide after 15 days. It is pointed out that the incident of petitioner No.1 to visit her parental house cannot be construed as an abetment to the victim to commit suicide.

In the meanwhile, petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C .”

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioners cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Hardeep does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Hardeep further states that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.09.2019 is made absolute.
