[1] Final result sheet of the petitioner for the post of Grid Sub-Station Operator in HVPNL against Advt. No.03/2016, Category No.05 in SC Category has been produced in sealed cover along with marks obtained by last candidate in the selected/waiting list. On opening the sealed cover, it transpires that the petitioner has secured 102 marks out of 200 marks as against 116 marks obtained by the last selected candidate and 115 marks obtained by the candidate in the waiting list in SC Category.

[2] Since, the petitioner has obtained marks lesser than the marks obtained by the last candidate in the selected/waiting list, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the writ petition pending.

[3] Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
