At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied, if the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioners in the light of the judgment passed in Surjeet Singh's case (supra).

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioners in view of the judgment passed in Surjeet Singh's (supra) and pass appropriate order accordingly in accordance with law.
