Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to investigate and register FIR against private respondents No.4 and 5 for committing crime of cheating, breach of trust, forgery, fabrication of documents, running a fake finance company and caused financial loss to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation dated NIL to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/7, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, to look into and decide representation dated NIL (Annexure P/7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
