Petitioner Geeta Devi has come in this civil writ
petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India praying

for writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to exercise the power to relax the condition for compassionate appointment imposed in Clause 4(ii) of the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules 2019 dated 08.02.2019 as in terms of Clause 42 of the 2019, Rules which provides for relaxing the Rules by the Government as husband of the petitioner namely ESI Baljeet Singh (now deceased) during the course of his employment suffered with chronic kidney disease-5D and due to deteriorating health condition, the deceased could not join the service after the age of 52 years and died on 24.09.2020 and her representation Anneuxre P/6 to that effect is pending before respondents No. 1 and 2.

In the light of oral submissions of the two sides directions are issued to the official respondent No.1 and 2 to duly consider the representation (Annexures P-6) of the petitioner in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of two months from the date of passing of this order.
