In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, to look into and decide representation dated 04.12.2020 (Annexure P/7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
