This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking action on application (Annexure P/1) moved by petitioner with further direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action against respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 20.01.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, to look into and decide representation dated 20.01.2020 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
