Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation into incident detailed in representation dated 05.06.2020 (Annexure P/4) as despite the fact that petitioner has sustained grievous injuries at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6, no action has been taken against them by official respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 05.06.2020 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into and decide representation dated 05.06.2020 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
