This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for conducting effective investigation expeditiously under direct supervision of some senior gazetted police officer in case FIR No.209 dated 16.10.2020 under Sections 148, 336 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mohkamura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 16.11.2020 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/8, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar, to look into and decide representation dated 16.11.2020 (Annexure P/8) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
