4. It has been conceded by the counsel for the parties that the present writ petition is covered by the decision of this Court in CWP No.20573 of 2020, titled as Rumiel vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 02.12.2020 whereby the writ petition has been accepted to be treated as appeal.

5. Consequently, it is directed that the present writ petition be also treated as appeal.

6. Counsel for the respondent-University states that he has instructions to aver that there are sufficient vacant seats.
