Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.0097 dated 21.06.2019 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, has placed on record a photocopy of the compromise effected between the petitioner and the complainant, which is taken on record as Mark 'A'. It is submitted that the petitioner is first offender; he is in custody since 21.06.2019; challan stands presented and charges are yet to be framed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Nishan Singh, has submitted that the compromise is not in knowledge of the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the complainant has not disputed the fact with regard to the compromise.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than 07 months; challan stands presented and the matter has been compromised between the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

This will, however, be subject to verification of the compromise by the Investigating Officer.

Petition is disposed of.
