The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 32 dated 21.02.2018, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 ('NDPS Act' - for short), registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail, but he could not appear before the trial Court on one date and consequently his bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 270 grams of heroin. After the registration of this FIR, the petitioner was also involved in another case bearing FIR No. 105 dated 22.11.2019, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kheri Gandian, wherein recovery of non-commercial quantity of heroin was

effected from him. In view of aforementioned facts and circumstances, I do not find it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
