The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 611 dated 08.11.2018, under Section 21C of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Hansi, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that 2 kilogram smack has been recovered from accused Sachin @ Shishan, who was arrested at the spot. Accused Sachin @ Shishan in his statement had stated that he had purchased the contraband from accused Safdar Ali and he was to deliver the same to the petitioner. He also contends that accused Safdar Ali, who had been arrested, did not name the petitioner in his statement. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated as there is another case pertaining to the recovery of 64 grams of smack against her. He further contends that the petitioner is a lady of the age of 22 years with three minor children.

This Court, by the order dated 27.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ajay Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 27.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
